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I, Steven N. Williams, declare and state as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney in good standing with the State Bar of California and admitted to practice in the Northern District of California. I am a partner of the Joseph Saveri Law Firm, LLP. ("JSLF"), Plaintiff's counsel of record. Our firm is one of the two firms appointed by the Court as Settlement Class Counsel. I have been principally responsible for the action since its inception. Unless otherwise indicated, I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein. If called as a witness, I could and would testify competently to them. I make this declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746.
- 2. This Declaration is submitted in further support of the Plaintiff's motion for final approval of the settlement between the Class and Defendant YouTube Inc., in settlement of this class action lawsuit against it and now pending before the Court for final approval.
 - 3. Since the last declaration that I submitted, CAFA notice has been completed.
- 4. Our firm and co-counsel continue to work with the Claims Administrator to ensure the best possible distribution of settlement proceeds to class members. We also receive and respond to inquiries from class members about the settlement.
- 5. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is an updated summary chart indicating the amount of time spent by the attorneys and other professional staff at JSLF who were involved in this litigation and the lodestar calculation based on JSLF's billing rates for the period from inception through May 10, 2023. The schedule was prepared from contemporaneous, daily time records regularly prepared and maintained by JSLF. An updated form of billing statement showing the full time entries is attached for the Court's review as Exhibit 2. The total amount for JSLF at current rates is \$516,630.50. The total lodestar for both firms is \$836,003.00 based on 1296.64 hours billed. For purposes of a lodestar cross-check, the requested attorneys fees of \$1,416,163.44, represent a 1.7 multiplier.
- 6. JSLFs hourly rates for the firm's attorneys, paralegals and law clerks included in Exhibit 2 are the usual, customary rates we charge.
- 7. Exhibit 3 is an updated chart outlining the itemized costs and expenses JSLF advanced the Class. JSLF has incurred a total of \$32,073.57 in costs and expenses incurred to date in connection with the prosecution of this litigation. These costs were incurred on behalf of the Class by JSLF on a

contingent basis and have not been reimbursed. The expenses incurred in this action are reflected in JSLF's books and records. These books and records are prepared from expense vouchers, check records and other source materials and represent an accurate recordation of the expenses incurred.

I have reviewed the time and expenses reported by JSLF in this case which are included 8. in this declaration. I affirm that they are true and accurate.

Notice Plan

- 9. I understand that KCC has fully complied with the notice plan ordered by the Court in its preliminary approval order. (ECF No. 63). The implementation and results of the notice program are summarized in the accompanying Declaration of Monica Murray.
- 10. The Class's notice and plan has been carried out. No class members have opted out of the settlements or objected to the settlement.

Final Approval Is Proper Under the Procedural Guidance for Class Action Settlements

- 11. Pursuant to the Northern District of California's Procedural Guidance for Class Action Settlements, the Class will file with the Court information about class members' responses. As ordered by the Court in its order granting preliminary approval for the present settlements, and in line with the Northern District of California's Procedural Guidance for Class Action Settlements, Class members had 35 days to object or opt-out after the filing date of instant motions for final approval and for attorneys' fees and reimbursement of costs and expenses. (ECF No. 65). No class members have opted out or objected to the settlement, an exceptional result.
- 12. The Claims Administrator completed CAFA notice on YouTube's behalf on January 12, 2023. and the requirements of the statute have been satisfied. 28 U.S.C. § 1715.
